Purpose: To provide students with the opportunity to develop the skills, discipline and confidence necessary to master college level mathematics, use mathematics in other disciplines, and be able to apply mathematics in daily living.

Developmental Mathematics Services:

- **Mathematics Placement Services:** Comprehensive mathematics placement testing is available six (6) days a week during the Fall and Winter Semesters. Call for test times during the Spring and Summer Terms. The math placement test is used by the Department of Mathematics for determining the appropriate mathematics course for students with less than a 19 score on the Math ACT and for students without a current ACT score (a testing date more than 3 years old). The Nursing Department uses the mathematics placement testing services to determine necessary entry-level math skills for admitting students to the nursing program. Test placement results have also been useful when working with the College of Business and the Economics Department in reviewing entry level skills for courses that utilize math and for business and economics courses that have math pre- or co-requisites. Athletes often schedule the mathematics placement test during the summer term in order to plan math courses for fall and/or winter semesters.
- **Developmental Math Courses:** The developmental mathematics courses – *Pre-College: Mathematical Concepts* (Math 097, Math 097A, Math 097B) and *Pre-College: Beginning Algebra* (Math 098, Math 098A, Math 098B) are offered during the Fall and Winter Semesters. Some developmental mathematics courses are offered during the Spring and Summer terms.
- **Mathematics Student Service Center:** Tutorial and testing services are available for students six (6) days a week in the Mathematics Student Service Center during the Fall and Winter Semesters. The center is also open during the Spring and Summer Terms. The center includes: a) a room for individual tutoring in all levels of mathematics, b) a test corrections room used by developmental math faculty to allow students to make corrections on tests, with tutorial guidance, c) a room for group tutoring, and d) a testing room for placement testing, make-up tests, re-testing, and gateway testing in a monitored and secure environment. Generally, hours are 9:00 - 9:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday, 9:00-4:00 p.m. Friday, and 10:00 - 4:00 p.m. on Saturday.
- **Math Teacher/ Placement Specialists:** An Administrator and seven Placement Specialists provide counseling to students who have math anxiety, who think they may need to take developmental mathematics, or who think they don't need developmental mathematics but have tested into developmental mathematics courses.
- **Developmental Mathematics Computer Lab:** A PC computer lab with software for developmental mathematics is available in the Pray-Harrold Building, room 503.
